## IDENTIFICATION AND ORIGIN

**Name:** Whole Black Beans

(Phaseolus vulgaris L.)

**Quality:** 4,300 – 5,500 grains per kilogram, medium hardness.

**Origin:** Eastern Lowlands of Bolivia (Santa Cruz de la Sierra)

**Variety:** Black beans with dark black seed coat.

## COMMERCIAL PRESENTATION

**Bulk Packaging:** 25 kg three-ply kraft paper bags or 50 kg polypropylene bags.

**Retail Packaging:** Doypack or trilaminate pouches in 500 g and 1000 g sizes.

**Secondary Packaging:** Pallets and corrugated cardboard boxes according to customer requirements.

**Labeling:** Customer's brand.
