IDENTIFICATION AND ORIGIN

Name: Brazil Nuts (*Bertholletia excelsa*)

Quality and Grades:

Medium: 110–130 nuts per pound

Midget: 160–180 nuts per pound

Special Broken: Approximately 2/3 of the nut, straight cut

Broken: Approximately 1/2 of the nut, straight cut

Jachi: Approximately 1/3 of the nut, straight cut

Origin: Bolivian Amazon (Beni)

Bulk Packaging: 44 lb boxes.
